VARIETAL ~ Pinotage/Petit Verdot/Cabernet Sauvignon/Petit Shiraz

STYLE ~ Ripe, juicy and slightly savoury flavours, this Pinotage-based blend shows the balance between fruit purity and elegance

HARVEST INFORMATION

- Type : hand-picked (early morning)
- Yield : 8-15 tons/ha
- Date : February - March
- Baling : 25,5°B

VINIFICATION

- Sorting of grapes, de-stemmed and crushed, cold soaking and slow fermentation at 25 °C to enhance flavours and colour
 - 10 months Barrel maturation

- Residual Sugar ~ 2.33/l
- Total Acid ~ 5.71g/l
